## **STREET HOCKEY GUIDELINES & RULES**

Thank you for entering the Hockey Is Life! Street Hockey Tournament! Below is a list of guidelines and rules in order to have the best and safest tournament possible. These rules are laid out for your benefit and safety.

### **Rules:**

#### Regular Play

- There are two conferences – the “Fun” conference and the “Competitive” conference. The rules for each are similar, but more aggressive play is permitted in the Competitive conference.
- 4 on 4, including 1 goalie on the court at ALL times.
- A maximum of 8 players will be permitted on each team.
- Play will be two periods of 15 minutes each, with a 5 minute intermission.
- Games will start on the hour, i.e. 9am, 10am, 11am, etc.
- No icing, no offside rules.
- No slap shots; sticks cannot be raised above the waist.
- Fun conference: No contact, no checking, no shoulder pads permitted. Competitive conference: Limited contact, no checking, no shoulder pads permitted
- Goalies must wear adequate protection & a mask at ALL times.
- Clock runs continuously; referee may add extra time if play has been slowed, at their discretion.
- The referee has the authority to end any game it deems the play is beyond disciplinary control.
- No players may be added to the roster without approval by the Street Hockey Administrator, and only due to unforeseen circumstances or injury.
- As this is a family-friendly tournament, profanity will NOT be permitted.
- Most other hockey rules apply.

#### Round Robin

- Each team will be guaranteed at least 3 games.
- Divisions will be a minimum of 4 teams. Due to entries received, some divisions may be amalgamated or expanded.
- Top two teams advance to a division final. Division final winners will play against other division winners until two teams remain, playing one final game for the “Hockey Is Life!” Tournament Trophy! One trophy will be awarded in the Fun conference and one in the Competitive conference.
- Standings tie breaker will be based on total goals for first, then total goals against next.
